

**Tobogganing Hindenburghütte 4km**

**TOBOGGANING**

Demanding toboggan run for experienced people, 4 km from the Hindenburghütte to Blindau.

Take one of the longest natural toboggan runs, 4 km, down into the valley with one or two-person sledges that you can hire. The toboggan run runs on a challenging route and requires tobogganing experience!

Daily fee-based bus transfer from the tourist information and from the Blindau car park to the Hindenburghütte, please note the operating times. Toboggan run open from around 12:00 p.m. Refreshment stop: Hindenburghütte

**Arrival by car**

Coming from Munich or Salzburg on the federal autobahn Munich - Salzburg (A8 to Grabenstätt exit no. 109), continue in the direction of Marquartstein and on the well-developed German Alpine Road (B305) to Reit im Winkl. Drive from the village in the direction of Ruhpolding. After approx. 1 km turn towards Blindau, approx. 1 km to the car park: -Fellhornweg, 832432 Reit im Winkl.

From Munich or Innsbruck on the federal motorway Rosenheim - Innsbruck (A93) to Oberaudorf (exit no. 59). Continue to Walchsee, Kössen and Reit im Winkl. Drive from the village in the direction of Ruhpolding. After approx. 1 km turn towards Blindau, approx. 1 km to the car park: -Fellhornweg, 832432 Reit im Winkl.

Paid bus transfer in the season from Tourist Info.

**Arrival by public transport**

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Prien am Chiemsee train station (best bus connection!). With the RVO bus line 9505. All timetables: [www.reitimwinkl.de](http://www.reitimwinkl.de). Stop directly at the tourist information.

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Ruhpolding train station with the RVO line 9506. Tourist Info stop.

Paid bus transfer in the season from Tourist Info.
