Tip : This hike also works by bus and train. Which bus, which stop, where to go? That's below. All public transport tips have been checked for suitability in practical tests.

From the starting point **at the Urschlau hiking car park**, take path no. 48 to the bridge over the Urschlauer Ache. On the other side just further and then steeply up to the "Oven". From there down to the **Röthelmoos Almen** and via a forest road back to the Urschlau starting point.

Refreshments : Langenbauern Alm (own cheese production, when it rains service in the Alm), Dandl Alm.

Without a car to Urschlau

- How to get there: RB 53 from Traunstein main station to Ruhpolding, change in Ruhpolding to the free village line
- Exit: Urschlau stop
- Route to the hikers' car park: Exit is directly at the hikers' car park
- Duration of arrival: approx. 40 minutes (without waiting time)
