


## Panorama Loop Winklmoos-Alm

## HIKING TOUR

Easy hike with nice places to stop for refreshments and great views.



Tip: This tour is also very good in bad weather, as you hike on paved forest roads, good hiking shoes are recommended.

From the Winklmoos-Alm car park walk first in the direction of the Heutal valley. At the junction near the Möserstube to the Wildalm, continue to the Finsterbachalm and to the left, uphill, walk on the forest path to the intersection of Finsterbachalm / Winklmoosalm. Turn left here to get to the valley station of the Dürrnbachhorn chairlift and on to the starting point.

Note: the tour can also be done in the reverse order.

Public transport: RVO bus line 9507 possible from Reit im Winkl or Seegatterl. The free hiking bus can be used on this tour. Please note the timetable!

## Arrival by car

Coming from Munich or Salzburg on the Munich - Salzburg (A8 to Grabenstätt exit no. 109), continue in the direction of Marquartstein and on the well-developed German Alpine Road (B305) to Reit im Winkl.

At the entrance to the village (Entfelden) in the direction of Ruhpolding approx. 5 km to the Seegatterl district, then via the toll road from Seegatterl to the Winklmoos - Alm. Parking: -Klammweg, 83242 Reit im Winkl.

Coming from Munich or Innsbruck on the federal motorway Rosenheim - Innsbruck (A93) to Oberaudorf (exit no. 59), on to Walchsee, Kössen and Reit im Winkl. Continue on the B 305 to Ruhpolding approx. 5 km to the Seegatterl district then via the toll road from Seegatterl to Reit im Winkl.

Parking: -Klammweg, 83242 Reit im Winkl.

## Arrival by public transport

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Prien am Chiemsee train station (best bus connection!). With the RVO bus line 9505 to Tourist Info, then change to line 9507.

Bus stop Winklmoos - Alm.

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Ruhpolding train station with the RVO bus line 9506. You can change to Seegatterl line 9507 to the Winklmoos-Alm. Stop Winklmoos - Alm.
