WINTER HIKING

Hiking in the wintry "Little Canada", the three-lake region between Ruhpolding and Reit im Winkl

Starting point

Lödensee car park

4.1 kilometres

Location

Ruhpolding

From the Lödensee car park, the path leads through an underpass into a dreamlike winter landscape: frozen lakes, snow-covered alpine meadows and the mountains of the Chiemgau Alps. It is not for nothing that this piece of earth not far from Ruhpolding is also called "Little Canada". The approximately four-kilometre-long, flattened winter hiking trail is a leisurely hike with only a few meters in altitude. On the way around Lödensee and Mittersee there is also a place to stop at Sepp at the Mitterseehütte.

Arrival by car

Approx. 11 km from Ruhpolding to the Lödensee or Mittersee car parks

Arrival by public transport

RVO (Regional Verkehr Oberbayern) bus on route 9506 Ruhpolding - Reit im Winkl with a stop at the Lödensee or Mittersee car parks
