The 30-kilometre-long adventure tour, which is signposted in both directions, begins at the **Tourist InfoWaging am See**. Along the western shore of the lake, it goes to the small **Taching**. A short visit to the **Sailerhof in Mauerham** is worthwhile, which, in addition to a cottage garden worth seeing, is also known for its excellent brandy and schnapps production. In **Tengling** the route branches east to the **Church of St. Coloman**. The short ascent is worthwhile because of the magnificent view over the chain of lakes in the foothills of the Alps. It continues south, always keeping an eye on the Salzburg and Chiemgau foothills of the Alps.

A breathtaking view of Lake Waginger See also opens up in **Bicheln**. From there it goes to Tettenhausen (known as a film set for "Dahoam is Dahoam"). The tour continues to **Petting** past cozy lidos, campsites and a mountain panorama board that explains the foothills of the Alps. A detour to the **Schönrammer Filz** is worthwhile here - a natural gem from the last Ice Age. The way back leads along the western shore of Lake Waging and ends back in Waging. We recommend a detour to the **church of Maria Mühlberg** enthroned high above, a well-known pilgrimage church with a wonderful view of both lakes.
