CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

A unique panorama opens up on the Tobias Angerer trail near Traunstein. The view extends over the snowy landscape of Chiemsee and Chiemgau to the Bavarian Alps.

On the Hochberg near Traunstein , cross-country fans can look forward to a trail with a unique panorama. The moderately difficult cross-country trail, which was designed together with overall World Cup winner in cross-country skiing **Tobias Angerer** and therefore bears his name, is suitable for both beginners and advanced skiers, for skating as well as for Nordic cross-country skiing. Thanks to the altitude, **the sun** and **unique panorama** are always there: to the south to the Chiemgau Alps , with a clear view to the west to Lake Chiemsee and the town of Traunstein.
